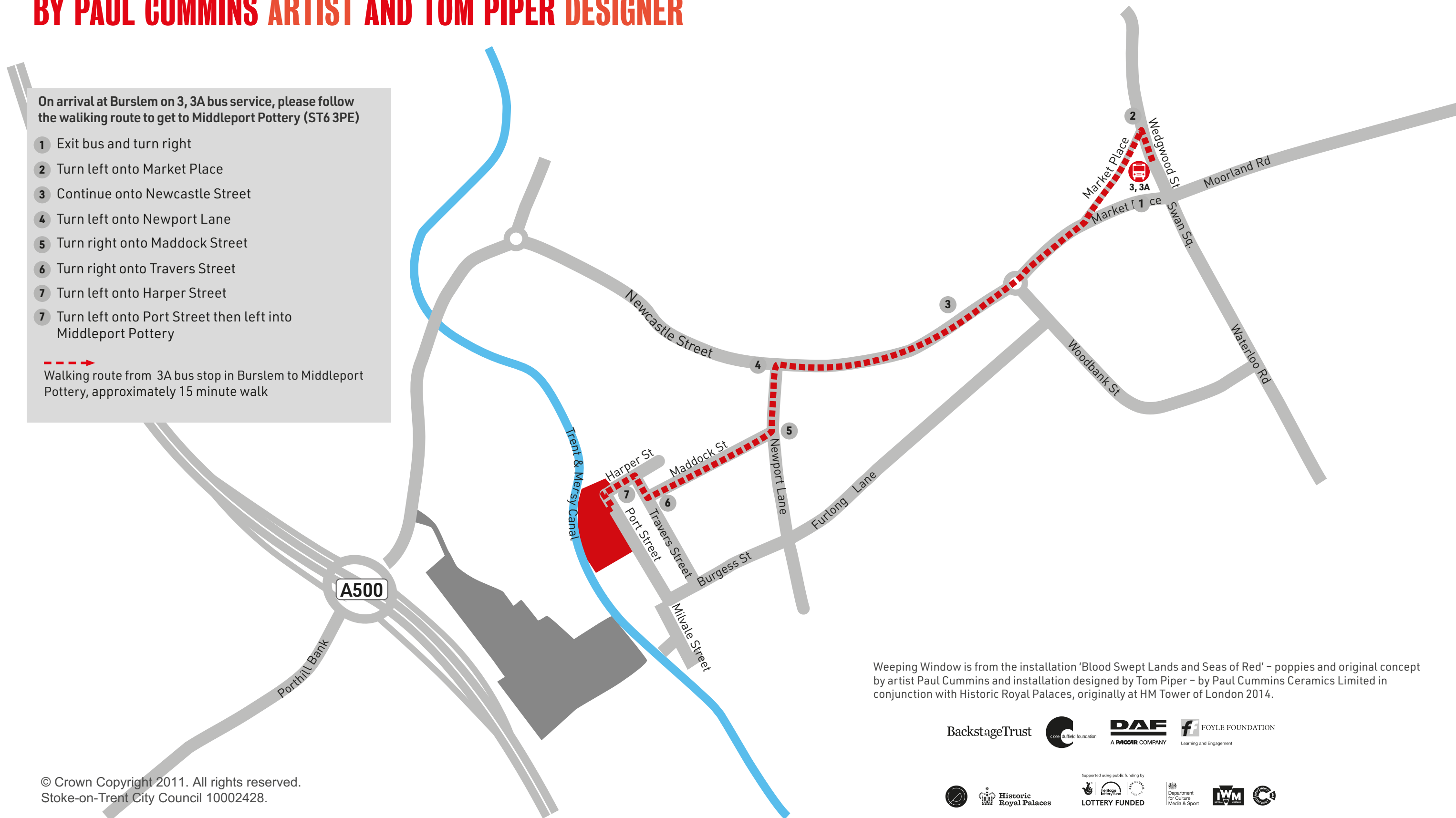
POPPIES: WEEPING WINDOW

On arrival at Burslem on 3, 3A bus service, please follow the walking route to get to Middleport Pottery (ST6 3PE)

- 1 Exit bus and turn right
- 2 Turn left onto Market Place
- 3 Continue onto Newcastle Street
- 4 Turn left onto Newport Lane
- 5 Turn right onto Maddock Street
- 6 Turn right onto Travers Street
- 7 Turn left onto Harper Street
- 7 Turn left onto Port Street then left into Middleport Pottery

Walking route from 3A bus stop in Burslem to Middleport Pottery, approximately 15 minute walk
