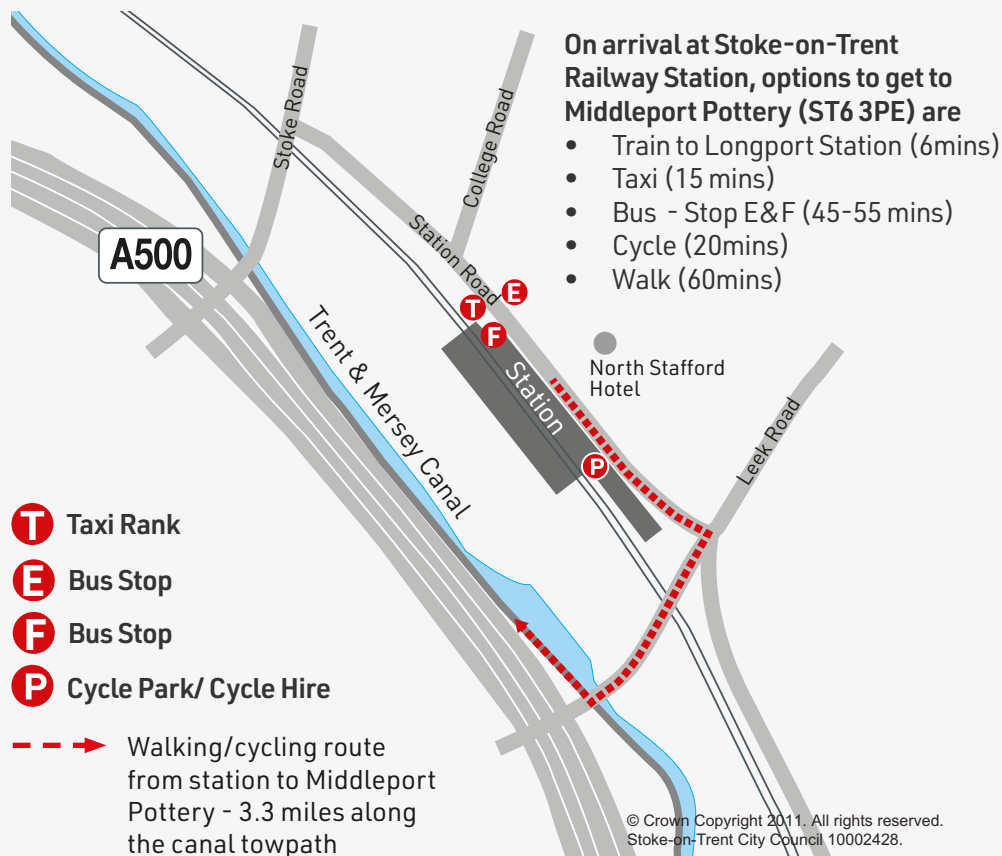

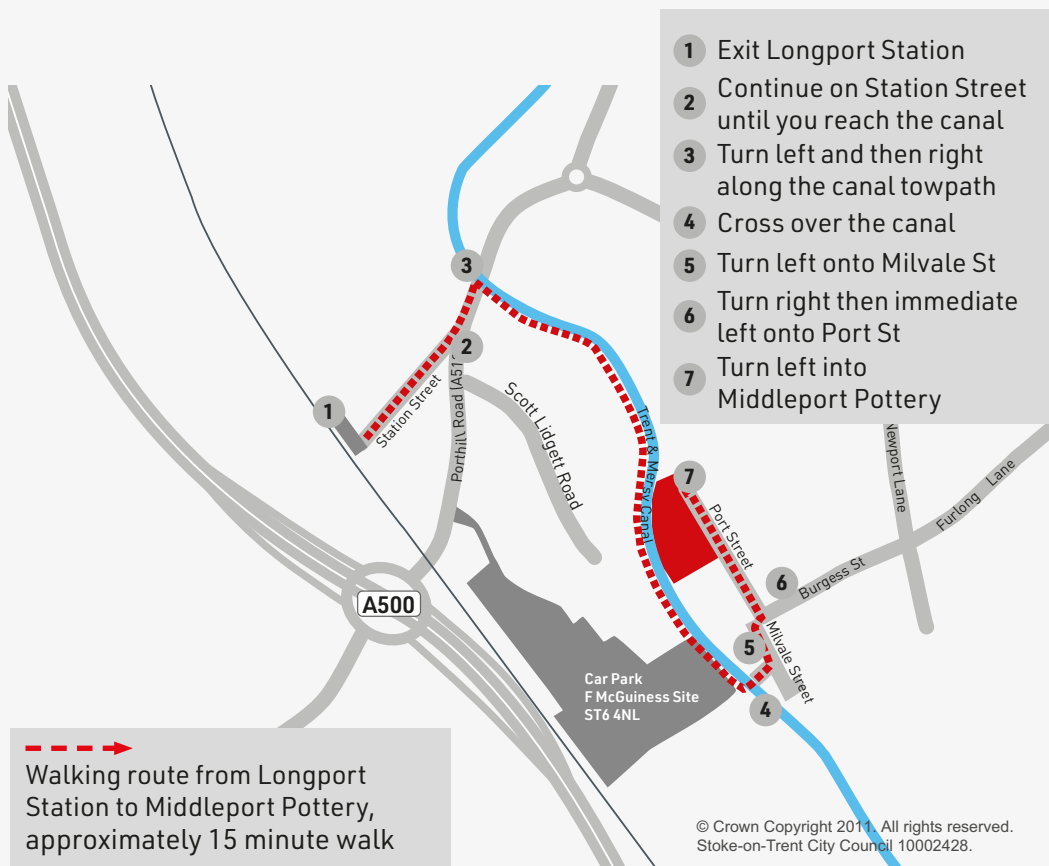

Train to Longport Station

- hourly service departing Stoke-on-Trent Station at 34 minutes past the hour.

Bus services

- From Bus Stop F: Any service to City Centre (Hanley). At City Centre Bus Station change onto service 3/3A and alight at Burslem. Approximately 15 minute walk from Burslem to Middleport Pottery
- From Bus Stop E: Services 9 or 25 to Newcastle-under-Lyme Bus Station. Change onto service 98 and alight at Longport Rail Station. Follow walking route on map above
